



In regard to the new Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture General Quarantine Order: the remaining PCLA season will proceed as scheduled. Somerset Spring Fling June 15<sup>th</sup> and Washington County Classic June 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Please see the updated guidelines that all hog exhibitors must follow to be eligible to show.**

3. Beginning June 1, 2019, no swine species shall be exhibited in this Commonwealth unless each animal meets all of the following criteria:

- a. Is accompanied by a CVI (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) that was issued not more than 30 days before the date of the show.
- b. Shall be permanently identified by an official ear tag and the ear tag number recorded on the CVI. Forms of official ear tag identification include:
  - i. USDA-issued metal ear tag with a US shield
  - ii. ISO-compliant 15-digit ear tag starting with "840"
  - iii. plastic show-issued stamped ear tag (Pennsylvania origin market hogs only)
- c. Has been visually inspected for signs of disease prior to unloading at the exhibition by an accredited veterinarian.
